

PE and Sport Premium

To help facilitate the improvement of PE, health and exercise for all children, the Government provides a grant to all primary schools across the country. During the 2017/2018 financial year, Skelton Primary School received £13,555 to be spent specifically on specialised coaching, teacher-training and improvements to equipment & resources for current and future pupils.

The following table details how this money has been spent (or is allocated to be spent before the end of the financial year):
