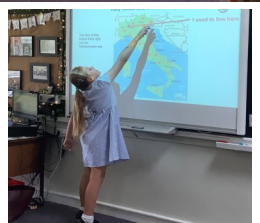
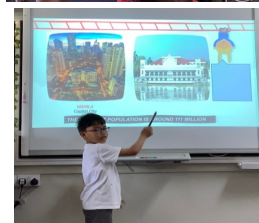
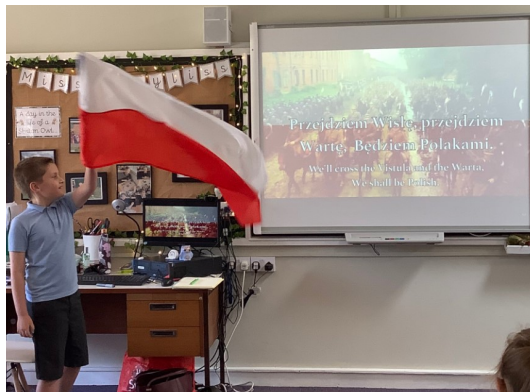
Robins have enjoyed learning all about China during culture fortnight. They have eaten Chinese food, learnt all about Chinese paper folding and built the Great Wall of China.

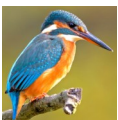
