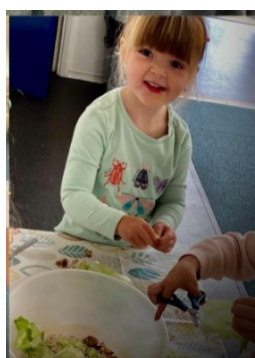

*It has been another amazing week in school. It is a joy to spend time in classrooms with our children and be a part of the brilliant learning that is happening.*

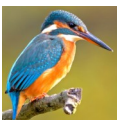
