Footwear

NB: *Open-toed or backless sandals should not be worn, even in the summer for health and safety reasons. 'Ugg' style boots are also not considered school uniform.*

- Trainers for outdoor PE.
- Plimsolls for indoor PE.
- A plain white polo shirt or T-shirt should be worn with plain dark shorts in summer.
- In winter, plain tracksuits may be worn.

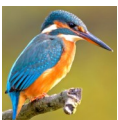
