Owls and Kingfishers (Year Five) went to Gilling Castle, spending the day outside and learning about the environment.



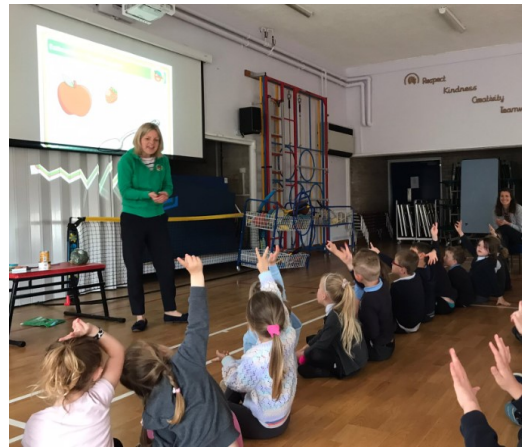
Gilling Castle trip

We got to talk about life cycles, listened to a story about Mother Earth, build fires, think about where food comes from and the importance of looking after our world.



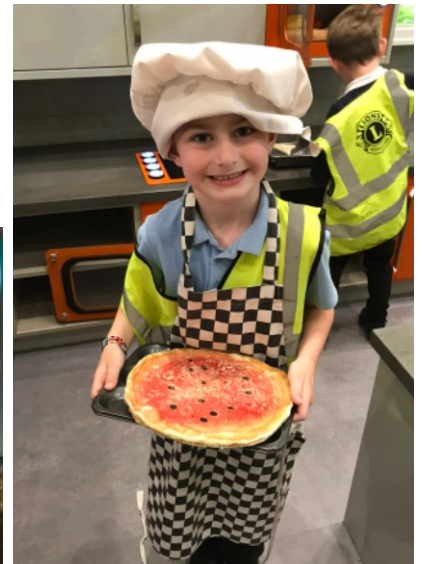
Phunky Foods!

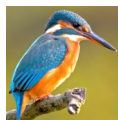
