#### Looking ahead: key messages and reminders

### **Changes to Reading Records and the Reading Chart**

We want to promote pupils to share their enjoyment of what they have read and encourage discussions about reading. We will be replacing the Reading Records and Reading Chart with a selection of alternatives. The Reading Ambassadors have chosen a variety of ways pupils can record what they have been reading.

- Reading List (every 10 books)
- Skelton Recommendation Card
- Drawing a storyboard (retelling the story)
- Book Review
- Drawing the front cover
- Drawing a character from the book
- Google Doodle (pick a word or the title and illustrate it in that style)

Templates for these will be available from school and for every one that is returned pupils will receive a raffle ticket entry to the half termly Reading Ambassador Prizes. The Reading Ambassadors will select winners in an assembly at the end of the half term and prizes will be handed out in school.

Main prize: 3 pupils will be selected to choose a book and have hot chocolate. Runners up: 10 pupils will win a bookmark.
